From inspiration prompts, a print out book dummy to fill in and a place to write down your story ideas. There is everything you need to write and create a picture book with your kids.



What You Need

Here are somethings you can use to create your book.





Instructions

Step One: The first step to creating your picture book in writing the story. Read through the prompt page and use your imagination to create a story. Who is your main character and what type of adventure do they go on?


Step Two: When you have your idea, write it down in the "Your Story" area and remember a good story needs:

- A beginning (this is where we meet the character and their environments)
- A middle (this is where the character goes on an adventure, meets other characters and discovers more of their world)
- A ending (this is where the character comes home and ends their adventure)

Step Four: Build the book, separate all your book pages and cover page. Bend the cover in half with the white empty side touching each other, then fold the internal pages in half with the empty whiteside on the outside of the fold and the black box on the inside. Then take the glue and glue the front page of the white side of the cover down onto the white folded page of the internal page. Continue this until you have reached the page count you want and then when you are finished glue the back cover onto the white page of the final spread.

Step Three: It's time to create your book! Using the book template you can draw each illustration and write all your words down on each page until you have your finished book and don't forget the cover!



Inspiration Prompts

You might be wondering what makes a good story, luckily a good story can be written about anything you can think of, let your imagination run wild. But if you need a little help here are some ideas to inspire you:

- A dog, cat and frog go on an adventure. (Where do they go and what adversities to they find on their journey)
- A lonely dragon finds a friend in an unlikely place (Where does the dragon meet his new friend? Who is his new friend)
- A sailor travels around the world in his little blue boat and discovers some amazing places (What places does the sailor discover? What does he see on his journey?)
- An Astronaut travels into space and makes an amazing discovery (What does she find in space? Does she meet anyone there?)
- A magical birthday party takes an unexpected turn.
 (Whos birthday is it and what happens unexpectedly at the party?)
- A ladybug builds a new home. (Why does the ladybug need a new home?
 What does her new home look like?)
